1 Update on Jesus Green development	<p>Alistair outlined plans for redevelopment of Jesus Green. This will include refurbishment / extension to the buildings around JG pool - possibly including meeting rooms and maybe even postal pigeon holes for boaters. Also some replanting works etc.</p> <p>The Council have applied for £4.5M Lottery funding for the project, but this is not guaranteed. If it isn't successful, the scale of the project will be reduced considerably.</p>	
2. Waiting lists	<p>The Council are consulting people on the waiting list about our proposed changes to the waiting list policy (Note from Andy - actually only about the widebeam aspect of it, if you read the letter!). They haven't had many responses.</p> <p>They agreed to send the consultation letter to all licence holders as well. At the AGM we should discuss the issue, and encourage people to respond to the consultation.</p> <p>Currently only 62 licences are in use. Teresa is still working through the list, and it is taking a long time to find genuine applicants.</p>	

<p>3. Mooring rings</p>	<p>Debbie reported that she has been advised that the provision of mooring rings may require planning permission. It may prove to be a very expensive exercise. She asked that we discuss with our members just how much these are really wanted.</p> <p>We will bring this up at our AGM and respond to the Council. (Note - have had a thought since - there are of course mooring rings along midsummer anyway (the lions). repairing / replacing these should not require planning consent - AR)</p>	
<p>4. Wash and noise from Rowers</p>	<p>Not much concrete to report on this. Agreed however to try to improve communication between rowers and boaters by holding joint meetings from time to time (probably every other meeting with the Council). Also, we should attend the novice coxes meeting and talk to them about the boating community (note from Andy - have now done this.)</p>
