Midsummer Fair, Midsummer Common, Cambridge 20 - 25 June 2007.

I write to inform you that the above event is taking place on Midsummer Common during the above dates.

Fairground equipment will be arriving on Sunday 17th June 2007.
Market traders will be arriving from 10.00am Monday 18th June 2007.

The event will be open to the public during the following hours:

Wednesday	20 th June	2.30pm – 11.00pm
Thursday	21 st June	5.00pm – 11.00pm
Friday	22 nd June	2.30pm – 11.00pm
Saturday	23 rd June	12.00 midday – 11.00pm
Sunday	24 th June	2.00pm – 9.00pm
Monday	25 th June	5.00pm – 11.00pm

Access to the tow-path will be blocked at the Fort St George with a small skip delivered and placed on Wednesday 20th June at 10.00am. This skip is used to prevent vehicles driving along the towpath and gaining access to the fairground during opening hours.

Police patrols will take place during the above event and will operate overnight until 04.00am. The patrol route is from Jesus Green Lock to Elizabeth Way bridge.

Whilst the above fun fair is on site and operating Cambridge City Council cannot accept liability for any damage to boats located in the mooring area immediately behind the fairground.
